CARE IN COUNSELING

We recognize the need and benefit of having one on one conversation in our pursuit towards endless growth. Sometimes an individual will need a discussion diving deeper into who Jesus is, a discussion to deal with past or current conflict and hurt, and there are times when a person may need to have conversation about a severe area of their life that is in turmoil or danger.

To best care for the individuals of Wellspring Church we acknowledge that the pastoral staff cannot always be the one to meet with said individuals. Conversation is best held where there is a relationship and sometimes conversation needs to happen with someone who is trained in a specific area of treatment. The staff and leadership understand that in some cases it is best to recommend an outside Counselor or Doctor to an individual.

When someone requests a conversation the first person they should meet with is their Life Group Leader, Team Leader, or Mentor. If a person is not connected to one of these communities, you as a leader may be reached out to if we believe you would be a good fit for an initial conversation.

If the Leader/Mentor believes that the situation is beyond what they can wisely handle we ask that they give the following information to the counselee and encourage them to take a step further by contacting someone from this list who is trained to specifically help them or by attending a support group that is specific to their need.
